4. Competition rules

Article 1. Organization

The EPZ Omloop van Borsele is organized by Stichting Wielercomité 's-Heerenhoek under the regulations of the International Cycling Union. It is to be held on April 22nd of 2023.

Article 2. Type of event

The event is open for athletes of the Women-Elite category. The event is entered on the UCI World Women calendar and is registered as a class 1.1 event. In conformity with the UCI rules, article 2.10.017, points scale Elite-Women:

1st =125 pnt, 2nd =85 pnt, 3rd = 70 pnt, 4th = 60 pnt, 5th = 50 pnt, 6th = 40 pnt, 7th = 35 pnt, 8th = 30 pnt, 9th = 25 pnt, 10th = 20 pnt, 11th = 15 pnt, 12th = 10 pnt, 13th = 5 pnt, 14th = 5 pnt, 15th = 5 pnt, 16th till 25th = 3pnt.

Article 3. Participation

As per article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations published 01-01-2023, the event is open for the following teams:

UCI Women's World Teams (maximum 5), UCI Women's continental Teams, National Teams^{*}, UCI cyclo-cross professional teams^{*}, Regional Teams^{*} and Club Teams^{*}.

As per article 2.2.003 of the UCI regulations, teams must be formed of minimum 4 and a maximum of 6 riders.

Article 4. Race headquarters

The race headquarters will be open starting April 22nd 2023 08:00 AM and is located at the following address:

Spek mie Stroop Marktstraat 16 4453 AJ 's-Heerenhoek

Team representatives are requested to confirm their starters and collect their race numbers at the race headquarters from 10:00 to 11:00 on April 22nd.

The team managers' meeting, organized in accordance with article 1.2.087 of the UCI regulations, in the presence of the Members of the Commissaires' Panel, is scheduled for 11:30 hrs. at: **Spek mie Stroop Marktstraat 16 4453 AJ 's-Heerenhoek.**

Article 5. Race information

The race has a total distance of 133,500 km: 1 round of 41 km, 3 rounds of 24 km and 2 rounds of 10 km

Start lists are available around 13.00 hrs. in the race headquarters, around 13.30 hrs. at the start location.

The start will be directly at 14.00 hrs. at the Kuijpersdijk. (There is no neutralized start)

Signing the presence list and the team presentation takes place from:

13:00 hrs. to 13:45 hrs. nearby tent situated in the Heerenstraat.

Line up of the following cars take place at the Kuijpersdijk at 13.30 hrs.

Line up of the cars in front of the race, takes place at the finish line at the Kuijpersdijk.

The feeding-zone is situated at 73 km. at the 's-Heerenhoeksedijk.

Also is here the drop zone for waste at start and end of feeding-zone.

There is also an intermediate sprint which will go over 3 rounds. See prices article 10.

Detour of vehicles is at 500 m before the finish at the left side of the road, parking possible on the parking ground of the church.

The finish of the race is around 17:00 hrs. Official results are available around 18.00 hrs in the race headquarters.



Article 6. Classifications

There is a general individual classification on time and a general team classification on time (based on the sum of the three best individual times for each team)

The team classification shall be calculated on the basis of the sum of the three best individual times for each team. In the event of a tie, the teams shall be separated by the sum of the places acquired by their three best placed riders on the stage. If the teams are still tied, they shall be separated by the placing of their best rider on the stage classification.

Article 7. Radio-tour

Race information will be broadcast on the following frequency: 155.9375 MHz

Article 8. Neutral technical support

The neutral support is taken care by the use of 3 neutral cars.

Article 9. Finishing time limits

2.3.039 Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 8% shall not be placed. The time limit may in exceptional circumstances be increased by the commissaires panel in consultation with the organizer.

Article 10. Prize Money according UCI.

There will be 4 intermediate sprints: The Zeeland challenges you Sprint

- 1e sprint: 41 KM - 1e Finish passage
- 2e sprint: 65,3 KM 3e sprint: 89,7 KM
 - 2e Finish passage
 - 3e Finish passage
- 4e sprint: 114,1 KM – 4e Finish passage

Each sprint with 5-3-1 points per sprint for the numbers 1 - 2 - 3 in sprint.

Prize schedule for the $1^{st} \notin 150$. for the $2^{nd} \notin 100$. -and $3^{rd} \notin 75$.

Rider has to finish the Road Race complete if not regulatory price comes to the next rider. Equal number of points is the official rule:

the finish classification shall be used to separate tied riders in the individual secondary classifications (art 2.3.037)



Article 11. Anti-doping

The UCI anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

Where applicable, that local anti-doping legislation would be implemented in addition to the ITA anti-doping rules on behalf of the UCI.

The Anti-doping tests will take place at health center, Laustraat 1's-Heerenhoek. Near by the finish (see page 8).

Article 12. KNWU Top competition

This event is part of the KNWU Top competition Series.

The KNWU Top competition Series consist of 7 individual events, and in an overall classification for individual riders, under 23 riders and teams ordered by the national federation and gives riders also qualifying possibilities for the national road championships. The regulations and the awarding points for these classifications are available in the KNWU federal regulations.

Article 13. Awards ceremony

The following riders must attend the official awards ceremony:

- The first 3 riders of the general individual classification of the event
- The leader in the KNWU TOPCOMPETITIE 2023"
- The leader in the under 23 "KNWU TOPCOMPETITIE 2023"

Article 14. Penalties

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

Article 15. Medical care


